The **International Sport for All Federation** (FISpT – Fédération Internationale du Sport pour Tous) is an official organization **recognized by the International Olympic Committee (IOC)**. As one of the only IOC-recognized organizations that focuses exclusively on the Sport for All movement, FISpT plays a crucial role in the global promotion of accessible and inclusive sports worldwide.

FISpT was founded on the 2nd of 1982 in **Strasbourg, France**, establishing itself as a pioneer in promoting sport for all principles across international borders. The federation subsequently relocated its headquarters to **Bahrain**, where it has been registered and operated in recent years. Building on this international experience and strategic expansion, FISpT is preparing to establish its headquarters in **Italy**, with this relocation planned to be formalized at the federation's next General Assembly.

- **Promoting "Sport for All"** – Making sport and physical activity accessible to individuals regardless of age, ability, socio-economic status, gender, race, religion, or cultural background

 - **Fostering International Exchanges** – Encouraging collaboration and knowledge-sharing across borders to advance the Sport for All movement

- Copy of the Passport
- A statement relating to the positions that you wish to run as candidate
